and Memory, Thanks be given unto God. Calling unto Mind the  
Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for  
for all Men once to Die do make and Ordain this my last Will  
& Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give  
and Recommend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God that  
gave it, and my Body I Recommend to the Earth to be buried in  
Decent Christian Burial, at the Discretion of my Executor —  
Nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall  
Receive the same again, by the Mighty Power of God.  
And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has  
Pleased God to Bless me in this Life. I Give Devise and  
Dispose of the same in the following manner to-wit.  
First I Give & Bequeath to Susannah Pickett my Dear Sister  
Wife of Mr. Thomas Pickett Trunk. Also I give and Bequeath  
to Rebecca Way my other Sister, all my wearing  
apparel and Trunk and likewise my Horse known by the

Name of Little Marsh, and likewise my Saddle, and also after payment of all my Debts, I give and Bequeath to my said Sister Rebecca, and Moses my Brother all my share of Lands Tenement or Appurtenances and Likewise all my Cattle or any thing else by them to be possessed and enjoyed.

I do likewise constitute & appoint Richard Fildes of Savannah Next John Way of Liberty County Planter my sole Executors, both of the State of Georgia, and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies, Bequests & Executors by me in any way before named, sealed, and Bequeathed, Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Fourth Day of May In the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Ninety four—  
Signed, Sealed, Published pronounced and Declared by the said Martha Way as her last Will and Testament in the Presence of us who in her presence and in the Presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our Names.
