whom I do hereby constitute make and ordain, the Executors
of this my last Will and Testament; And as touching such
Worldly Estate wherewith God has blessed me,

I give, devise, and dispose of the same in the following manner,
and form: First I will, desire, and ordain, that all my perso-
nal Estate, as soon as convenient after my decease be by my Exe-
cutors of renamed, publickly sold, to the highest bidder, for Cash,
and that all my just debts, the expences attending my Sickness,
and funeral expences, be faithfully paid. Secondly I give
and bequeath unto James Monfries my Negro Vencho named
Mary together with her Issue, to hold to him his Heirs and
Assigns forever, in full satisfaction he may have against me.

Thirdly I give to who was lately my Wife, but
was proven that she had her husband alive, when I married her, one
Shilling, if she demands it. Fourthly I Give unto David Leby
the sum of Eight Dollars, and I give unto John Haught junior the
sum of Six Dollars. and Fifthly all the residus and remainder
of my Estate as aforesaid, together with the Cash and outstanding
debts, I give and bequeath unto my Parents, namely George Hen-
rich Wilson, and Sophie his Wife, being in the village of Worstet
in the County / Land / of Gym in the Electorate of Hanover,
and in case of their Decease, to my Brother and my Two Sisters,

disinvoile, and every other Testaments, Wills, Legacies Bequeathed, and Executors by me in any ways before named, wills and bequeathed. Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of January in the Year of our Lord seventeen hundred and thirty four.

Signed, Sealed, published, pronounced and declared by the said Nicholas Witzen, as his last Will and Testament in the presence of us, who in his presence, and in the presence of each other, hereunto subscribed our Names.
