Thirdly I give to ~~the said~~ ^{who was lately my Wife,} but was proven that she had Husband alive, when I married her, one Shilling, if she demands it. Fourthly I give unto David Leby the Sum of Eight Dollars, and I give unto John Haupt junior the Sum of Six Dollars. and Fifthly all the residue and Remainder of my Estate as aforesaid, together with the Cash and outstanding Debts, I give and bequeath unto my Parents, namely George Henrich Wüsten, and Sophie his Wife, being in the Village of Warflet in the County (Land) of Osn in the Electorate of Hanover, and in case of their Decease, to my Brother and my Two Sisters,

disannul, all and every other Testaments, Wills, Legacies Beque-
aths, and Executors by me in any ways before named, willed and
bequeathed: Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be
my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and Seal this fourth day of January in
the Year of our Lord seventeen hundred and Ninety four.

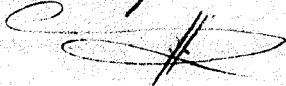
