In the name of God, Amen. I Thomas Estes being, rather infirm in Body, but of Sound Mind, and Conscious of the uncertainty of humaine life do make this my last Will & Testament. After the pay-
ment of my just Debts, I devise and bequeath my
Property in the following manner viz.

Imprimis. I devise to my wife Sarah all my real
estate, consisting of a body of land in the County of Liberty
Containing four hundred and fifty acres, composed of
three adjoining Tracts granted to me as will appear by
the three several Grants, now in my possession to
her and her heirs for ever.

Item. I Devise to my Sons David and Solomon
all my Stock of cattle to be equally divided between
them, each one to receive his proportion at his arrival
at the age of twenty one, or being married, and in case
of the death of either before such event, his proportion shall
become the property of the Survivor.

And whereas a Suit is now depending in the Superior Court
of Liberty County in which I am Plaintiff, and James
Threat Administrator of Richard Box, is Defendant to
recover damages for a receipt in the Sale of a Negro Woman
and Child, it is my Will and desire and I do hereby bequeath
to the proceeds of such Suit, whether ended in my life
time, or prosecuted and recovered by my representatives
to be divided equally between my Sons David & Solomon
at the arrival of the events aforesaid, and the proportion of
either in case of his Death before his Marriage, or removal
at the age of twenty one as aforesaid to go to the other.

All the rest of my Estate real and Personal \$2000⁰⁰ and begin
with to my said wife Sarah.

I do hereby appoint my wife Sarah, Execu-
tor and Matthew Bennet Executor of this my last
Will & Testament. And I empower my said wife
to make Bullets by the same Stock, and to appro-
priate the proceeds thereof, in such manner as she
pleases, for the benefit of herself and children, during
their minority or remaining unmarried; and I
empower my said Executor and Executrix to sell the
Mills belonging to the aforesaid Stock, for the pur-
pose of educating and clothing my said Sons
David and Solomon. In witness whereof I have

the Year Seventeen hundred and Thirty four.
