I the subscriber Charles Radiguey, born at Mortray in the formerly Province of Normandia in France, and Inhabitant of Quarten d'aguen Island of St. Domingo now living in Savannah in Georgia, One of the United States of North America, do declare solemnly in the presence of the subscribing Witnesses that in case of death the present contains my last Will & intentions as follows — 1st I name and institute for my only heir and universal Legatee, My beloved Wife Mary Francis Linard, born in Paris, who ought to be at present living in the said Quarten d'aguen Island of St. Domingo, and I devise and recommend to my Executors hereafter named, that as soon as the business of my Estate will be done, and my lawful debts, if any, will be paid, to send the remainder of my Estate in whatever it may consist, either Money, buildings, Raticals, money or any thing else, to my said Wife by the safest and next opportunity.

I give and bequeath her besides all my property real and personal and all the rights whatsoever I may have in the Island of St. Domingo, in France or elsewhere. And I authorize her to take possession and dispose of the whole as she will think proper, as soon as circumstances will permit —

2^d I appoint for my Executors M. Lewis Nicholas Allard, and M. Francis Sainerie, my friends now living in Savannah and beg of them to take the trouble to fulfil the content of this, jointly or severally, it is the last service that they can render to me, and I pray them

to accept by the present the testimony of my most sincere
gratitude. —

Lastly 3^d. There will be found among my papers a Note
of hand of \$7. — on the about subscribed to me by the
said Francis Sainier. I desire that the said note will be
returned to him receipted, as I have no pretensions in it other
I give it up and make him a full gift of it. —
