 Hannah Deffen with their increase Tom Whill may & shall be
 manumitted & set free from Slavery, Item, I give and
 bequeath all my other negroes to wit, Bob, Nero, Ben, Aco,
 Jimmie & Peter, & also all my cash on hand, & all the residue
 & remainders of my estate real personal or mixed to my 2^d
 Wife I give my dearly beloved Mother Elizabeth
 Deffen & my 2^d nieces Sarah Crawford, Mary Crawford
 & Fanny Crawford, I have & do hold the 2^d negroes cash &
 the remainder & residue of my Estate to the 2^d Joanna Elizabeth
 Sarah Mary and Fanny & their heirs Executors admi-
 -nistrators & assigns for ever, to be divided among them
 equally, when & where alike, & moreover I do by these
 presents nominate constitute and appoint
