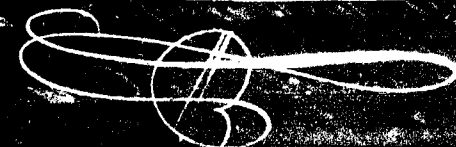

of the deceased to be equally divided between the surviving Children
Children, I am also desire that my Stock of Cattle Hogs, &c
one horse saddle & bridle to be sold by my Executors hereunto
mentioned also such other articles as my Executors may see convenient
in order to pay debts, I am also constitute & appoint the above mentioned
Joseph Rubin & my nephew, John Zettler, both of the County of Georgia
to be my lawful Executors to this my last Will & Testament
this sixteenth day of June Eighteen hundred being the
twenty fourth year of the Independence of America.
