lot now or late the Property of William Bolcher, as
which said lot was purchased by me from Wil-
liam Thomson, and Harriett Cunningham Thomson
his Wife and conveyed by their Attorney William
Munn, who was duly and specially appointed for
that purpose To have and to hold the said
Wharf lot and all and singular the rights, Members
and appurtenances therein belonging unto him
the said James McCreedy his heirs and assigns for ever

Third I give and bequeath unto Eliza H.
Scoffield as a reward for her constant kindness and
attention to me during a long and painful illness the
Sum of Five hundred Dollars to her her heirs and
Assigns for ever to be paid by my Executors out of the
residue of my Estate after the payment of my just debts
and other Expenses attending the Administration of
my Estate are paid and satisfied.

Fourth It is my Will and desire that my Slave
Woman Mary shall be free And as this cannot be
effected but by consent of the Legislature of the State I do
hereby direct my Executors hereon after named to make
a Petition for that purpose, and have the said Slave
Woman Mary Manumitted and discharged from
all manner of servitude and Slavery whatever.

Fifth I give Devise and bequeath unto my Bro-
ther David McBride of the City of Charleston Merchant
all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate both
real and Personal of whatever Nature or Kind, and
wherever situate or being which I may die possessed of
or entitled unto For trust and to and for the Children
of my Sister Jane or such of them as shall live and

Assigns, as he the said David McBride my said Brother
 may by such or other instrument, in Writing select and
 point out for that purpose, To have and to hold
 the same and every part or parcel thereof
 unto the said David McBride in trust as
 aforesaid his heirs and assigns forever -
 Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint
 my said Brother David McBride and
 my friends David Pryde Mitchell Wm
 Melan and Joseph Miller Executors of this
 my last will and testament hereby revoking
 all other and former will or wills by me at
 any time heretofore made In Testimony of
 which I have hereunto subscribed my name
 and affixed my seal at Savannah in the
 State aforesaid this twelfth day of March
 One thousand Eight hundred & seven
