God to bless with you and dispose of the same as follows I bequeath
and give with and desire that all your heirs and personal executors to fully
pay and discharge as soon as conveniently may be after my decease and
after payment thereof I give and devise unto my grandson George
King the son of William King of the County of Effingham, Georgia
a tract of Land containing four hundred acres situate and being
in the district of land in the State of South Carolina and being
between lands of Lewis Hurre and Mr. Heyward to hold to my
said grandson his heirs and assigns forever I give and devise unto my
grandson Benjamin King a tract of Land containing two hundred
acres situate and being in the said district of Beaufort South
Carolina adjoining lands of the Reverend Mr. Smith to hold to the
said Benjamin King his heirs and assigns forever I give and devise unto
my grandson James King a tract of Land containing four hundred
acres situate and being in South Carolina in the district of Beaufort aforesaid
to hold to the said James King his heirs and assigns forever I give and devise
unto my grand daughter Elizabeth King a tract of Land containing one
hundred acres situate and being in the State of Georgia to hold
to her she and Elizabeth King her heirs and assigns forever And I do
give and devise unto my grandson David joining the son of David
joining of the Nathaniel Hardin, the father of Beaufort aforesaid
Georgia a tract of Land containing two hundred acres in the said district
of Beaufort and known by the name of School To hold to my said
grandson David joining his heirs and assigns forever I give and devise
unto my grandson Samuel joining his heirs and assigns
situate in Beaufort district aforesaid and being one hundred

and desire unto my said son Jacob and Benjamin equally between them
with such other lands as I may be possessed of where ever the same
may be found as my will and desire shall notwithstanding the disposition
before made of my lands and tenements my said wife Catherine
shall and may during the term of her life if she shall so long continuing
widow live and reside in any of my lands as far as she shall choose
and be allowed such furniture for the same as she shall think proper except
any one of my children with sufficient land for placing or
alternately in town and country as she shall please which will secure and
remains of my inheritance whatsoever and wherever and of reser-
vation and Reversion I give and bequeath unto my wife Catherine
and my said children Jacob Benjamin and Anne to be equally divided
between them share and share alike and I hereby nominate constitute and
appoint my said wife Catherine (during her widowhood) Governor
and my said sons Jacob and Benjamin Executors of this my last will
and testament hereby revoking all former and other wills by me at any time
heretofore made declaring this only to be my last will and testament

before set my hand and seal the twenty sixth day of February in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three and in the twenty seventh year
of Abraham Lincoln
