First I do hereby order that my estate hereafter to be appointed as pay all my Just debts and funeral charges out of the Chatham estate as shall belong to me at the time of my decease and which is not granted is given to my wife that well and lawfully

Also I give and bequeath unto my wife Elizabeth nothing for her use and benefit So much to her during her natural life, the plantation on which I now live remaining unto my sons of Land being within the State of

Wilmington in the County of

and after her death to be divided to my sons together with my

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together and last I am to give
 and further I give and bequeath unto my sister Elizabeth De Haven the sum of ten
 and upwards of all the highest and other debts which of which I shall die
 possessed of except a sum of five hundred dollars to be paid to my brother John
 Turner by my executor year after year for living life
 And after the death of my sister Elizabeth De Haven all the estate which I own
 propose to be equally divided among my said sister's then surviving children
 together with the increase of said property
 All the rest of my worldly goods whatsoever and wheresoever after the
 death of my said sister I give devise and bequeath unto Anne Day &
 Louis Turner De Haven as well above to be equally divided among them
 And if either of the said children should die without issue the whole
 of their portion to be equally divided between the two surviving ones and in
 case they all should die without issue then in that case all things above
 to be equally divided among my Brother Richard Turner's children above
 then alive except Louis who is to have one one above the rest the whole
 of Louis's share I have here
 Lastly I hereby nominate my Brother Richard Turner my brother John
 Turner and my friend Edmund Chadwick of this my last will and
 testament hereby revoking all former wills or wills by me heretofore
 made made

 testament made and signed at my hand and seal this 10th day of July
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & in the twenty fifth
 year of the independence of the United States of America

 by the said testator as and for his last

 us his friends & in the presence of each
 other have subscribed our names as
 witnesses hereto
