

State of Georgia. In the name of God am I witness
S. Walleran Shaffer of the City of Savannah in the State being
in good health mind memory and understanding but con-
sidering the uncertainty of human life do make ordain
and declare this to be my last Will and Testaments in
manner and form following. Herby revoking all former will
by me heretofore made; I will and devise that my Estate
be kept together until all my just debts are paid, and
the profits thereof applied to the payment of all my just debts
paid, and the profits thereof applied to the payment of my just
debts, but out of the profits my daughter Hannah is to be
maintained until my Estate is out of debt when the same
may be divided; I give and bequeath to my Daughter
Hannah Shaffer one negro Wench to hold to her and her heirs
and aforesay forever, not to be subject to any future husband
she may have, but for her sole and separate use, the said
negro to be chosen by her from any that I die possessed of.
She to have her choice also of one good feather bed or Bed
two Pillows, to be made of the best material; this bequest is not
to be considered as a part of her equal share of my Estate. I
give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Ann Guittard
the right of Power that she possessed when I married her of it and
the land formerly John Polk's, and now under lease to John
Glasp and his Representatives. I also give and bequeath unto my
said wife, those two houses and lots in Carpenter's Row, the one in
which I now reside, and the adjoining with the improvements
Also two negroes, the one named Betty, and one other negro Wench
to be chosen by her out of those I die possessed of, after my daughter
Hannah shall have chosen one as bequeathed to her to hold
the said lots and negroes unto my said wife during her natural
life, and after her death the same be divided. Between my Children
and Grand Children agreeable to the acts of Distribution of the
State of Georgia. And should the property thus bequeathed be
insufficient to maintain my said wife, I will and direct that
my executors and trustees out of my other Estate as such as to
furnish her a gentle maintenance during her life as aforesaid
Whereas I am justly indebted to my son Simon Peter in a
certain sum of money given to him some years ago by Mr. John
Smith for which I promised to pay him interest until he attains
the age of twenty one years, and as an equivalent for the said
debt, I give devise and bequeath unto my said son Simon

Peter the sum of one hundred Dollars; they bequest is not to be considered as a part of his equal share of my Estates.
I desire my lot in Wilmington Tything Darby ward to be divided into two equal parts, that is as nearly equal as the townsmen thereon will admit, my lot at Eversburgh and my lot at New Leids have already Divided and laid off by my Direction as will appear by the Platts annexed hereto Will. Into seven divisions and number in the said Platts from number one to number seven, which with the first division of my lot in Darby ward makes nine parts, which nine parts are to be valued by three Freeholders to be chosen by my Executry - I give devise and Bequeath unto my Grand Children Joseph Lawrence Shaffer and Sarah Shaffer, Children of my eldest Son John William Shaffer deceased to be equally divided between them, and to their heirs and assigns, one half of my lot in Wilmington Tything Darby ward being the Eastern half - I give devise and bequeath unto my Son George his heirs and assigns the Western half of my lot in Wilmington Tything Darby ward - I give devise and bequeath unto my grand Children Elizabeth Margaret Shaffer and Harriet Shaffer, and to their heirs and assigns, share & share alike Children of my Son James Shaffer deceased one of the Seven parts of my lots laid off by the annexed Platts, being numbered in said Platts number One/1,

I give devise and bequeath unto the Children of Frederick Shaffer that survive their share and share alike, and to their heirs and assigns one other of the seven parts of my lots laid off by the annexed Plat, being numbered in said Plat number two - I give to my son Jacob his heirs and assigns one other of the seven parts of my lots, laid off by the annexed Plat, being numbered in said Plat N^o 3 (Five), I give to my son Simon Peter his heirs and assigns one other of the seven parts of my lots laid off by the annexed Plat, being numbered in said Plat N^o 4 (Four), I give devise and bequeath unto John Martin Gugel his heirs and assigns one other of the seven parts of my lots laid off by the annexed Plat, being numbered in said Plat number 3 (Three), - I give to my daughter Anna and for her separate & sole use, not subject to the debts & controul of any husband she may have and to her and assigns, one other of the seven parts of lots laid off by the annexed Plat, being numbered in said Plat number 5 (Five).

At my decease. The foregoing bequests of the eight parts of my
lot shall be received by my Children & Grand Children
respectively at the valuation thereof in front of their equal
share of my Estate, but should any part be valued at
more than any share, then the difference shall be paid
to my Executors, to be divided with the other shares so as to
make each part equal - I do hereby appoint George
Shaffer and Jacob Shaffer Guardians to and for my said
Children Hannah and Simon Peter, I own sundry land,
and the seventh part of my lots, numbered in the aforesaid
Plat, No. 6, which I desire may be valued by three
discreet persons to be named by my Executors, and any of
my heirs that may wish to have the same, may take the same
at the valuation above directed to be made. Should more than
one of my Heirs wish to have the above mentioned land or any
part thereof in that case they shall cast lots for the same if
none of my Heirs wish the lands, the same shall be sold
by my Executors to the best advantage, and the proceeds add
to my personal Estate. It is my will and desire that the
remainder of my Estate be valued as the lands are directed
to be valued, and then divided between my Children and
Grand Children, in manner following that is to say, one eighth
part thereof to go to my Grand Children Joseph Lawrence
Shaffer and Sarah Shaffer Children of my deceased Son John
William Shaffer to be equally divided between them, one eighth
part thereof to go to my son George Shaffer, one eighth part
thereof to go to Elizabeth Margaret Shaffer and Harriet Shaffer
Children of my deceased Son James Shaffer to be equally divided
between them, One eighth part thereof to go to the Children of my
Son Frederick Shaffer that may survive him to be equally divided
between them, One eighth part thereof to go to Jacob Shaffer
my Son, one eighth part thereof to go to my son Simon Peter
one eighth part thereof to go to my Grand Son John Martin Gager
and the remaining eighth part thereof to go to my daughter
Hannah. Should any of my Children or Grand Children
die without lawfull issue his or her share of my estate herein
stated to be divided between my heirs, according to the Act
of distribution, Lastly I do hereby nominate, constitute and
appoint George Shaffer, Jacob Shaffer, Ulrich Sobier & Dennis
Cugler to be my Executors to this my last Will and Testament
dated at Savannah the fourteenth day of June one thousand

eight hundred and ten.

said Testator as his last Will and
Testament contained in three half sheets
of paper, in the presence of us who in
the presence of each other saw the Testa-
tor have subscribed our names at
Metzger's Tavern to witness it before.
