my negro woman Judah and her two children the
one named Pooz the other Rachel also the increase
of the said negroes to be for the Heirs of the said
Ann & William forever if the said Ann or William
should chance to die then the other is to have the
other half of this property if both should chance to
die then this property is to fall to Daniel Joiner
that is to say one half of the said property the
other to be equally divided amongst the Heirs of
my body I Also give and bequeath to Ann
Fifteen Head of Cattle usually called her own prop-
erty I also give the remaining part of my stock of
Cattle to the said Wm Gibbons — I Also give
Two feather beds one for each of the said children
I Also give and bequeath to the said little Ann
One trunk full of Cloathes — also one Chest for the
said William — I also request that my negro woman
named Chain may work two years at least for the
benefit of the said Children's support —
In faith of this I set my Hand Here. I also
give for the support of these two children Forty Dol-
lars which I now have to be given up at my
Death I also wish it known after my Death
to leave the Care of these Children to Rob^t Brown and
Celia F Dotson (18)
