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This is the last Will and Testament of me  
Charles Boyd of Chatham County in the State of Georgia  
Planter —

First I will and direct that my Negroes Horses Stock  
and other property now on the Plantation where I reside  
may be kept and continued there together untill the Crop  
which is now growing shall be made and gathered for  
market, and I also will and direct that my just  
Debts shall be paid with the proceeds of the Crop —  
and if my wife Barbara Boyd should be inclined to  
remain and reside at the said Plantation I wish to  
request that my son Charles would permit her to do  
so as long as she pleases — Also I give and be-  
queath to my son Charles Boyd my neg<sup>ro</sup> woman Lucy  
and my mare —

Also I give and bequeath to my son James Boyd  
my neg<sup>ro</sup> boy [illegible] and my young  
neg<sup>ro</sup> [illegible]

House. Also I will and direct that my negro  
man Peter be sold by my Executor and I Give  
and bequeath one half of the sum of money for  
which the said Negro may be sold to my son  
James Boyce and the other half of the said sum  
of money I give and bequeath to my Daughter  
Mary Camp Wife of Thomas Camp for her sole  
and separate use and not to be subject to the  
Control intermeddling or disposition of her hus-  
band and I will and direct that the said money  
shall be so disposed and secured as may be most  
advantageous for my said daughter and the  
support of her children — Also I Give and  
bequeath to my wife Barbara Boyce my chaise  
Horse called Blunder and my riding chair &  
Harnes and Two Cows and Three Calves, Yearlings  
which are distinguished from the rest of my Cattle  
as hers — and also the Household furniture Bed  
and Bed furniture which she had at the time  
of our intermarriage. Also I give and bequeath  
to my two sons Charles & James and my daughter Mary  
Camp all the remainder of my Cattle & Hogs equally  
to be divided among them Share & Share alike —  
Also I give and bequeath to my son Charles &  
James Boyce a Bed & Bed Furniture each —  
Also I give and bequeath all my plantation land  
and Cart to my said two sons equally to be di-  
vided between them Share and Share alike and  
also all my Household furniture not herein  
before bequeathed to be equally divided between  
my said two sons — Also I give devise and  
bequeath all the rest residue and remainder  
of all my Estates and Effects real or personal  
so ever & where so ever not herein before otherwise  
effectually disposed of to my said two sons  
Equally to be divided between them Share &  
Share alike — And I do hereby make constitute  
and appoint my wife Barbara Boyce Ex-  
ecutrix and my son Charles Boyce Execu-  
tor of this my last will and Testament  
revoking all former wills by me  
heretofore made — this to be in full
