Know all
men by these presents that I Elizabeth McQueen
Wife of Alexander McQueen Esq of
the County and State aforesaid by virtue of a
Power or Powers reserved to me in and by a
Deed of Indenture bearing date the twenty
first day of April in the year one thousand
seven hundred & ninety five made by and
between my Brother Thomas Fuller of Beaufort
in the State of South Carolina of the one part
and William Fuller and John Barnwell
Trustees nominated for the particular purposes
therein expressed purporting to be a deed of gift
of nineteen Negroes from my said Brother
Thomas to me for the benefit and advantage
of myself and children and whereas I
am by the said deed at Liberty and have
full power and authority reserved to make my
last will and Testament or any appointment
to that effect whereby I can direct and dis-
pose of the use and profits of said Negroes, as I
shall think most fit and proper and also where-
as my said Husband Alexander McQueen
hath fully contracted, agreed and empowered me
to make my will or appointment of any prop-
erty real or personal which I now am or here after
may claim without the hindrance obstruction
or legal impediment of my Marriage State aris-
ing from him or any person claiming under
him I do therefore by virtue of the
afore power and authorities to me delegated
and granted hereby make and ordain my
last will and Testament and do hereby par-
suant to the said Power and Powers and to all
and every other Power and Powers whatso-
ever, order direct, give limit and appoint
in manner following and first I give
and bequeath to my beloved daughter

Harriet, Maria & Eliza as follows to my
Elders Daughter Harriet I give and bequeath
a negro wench named Fudiths unto
my daughter Maria a negro girl named
Sally and to my daughter Eliza a negro
girl named Molly together with their
future issue and increase to them their
Executors, administrators and assigns
and as for the negroes named
in the said deed part bequeathed and
other negroes and property real and per-
-sonal of what ever kind it may be which I
claim in my own right or can hereafter claim
by the death of my Mother Wm. Fuller or from the
Estate of my Father, or from the death of my Mother
or by any means, or right whatsoever -
I do hereby give and bequeath unto my
Children daughter and so on as may be living at
the time of my death - the aforesaid specific
legacies - not making part of the dividend in
favor of my daughter Harriet, Maria & Eliza
all my property real and personal and particularly
the negroes mentioned in the said Deed and those
which I can claim by will or descent in my fa-
-vor or any other manner with the future issue
and increase of the female slaves to them, their
Executors administrators assigns and increase
of them should die before the Children should
arrive or the age of three & twenty years, or the
day of marriage then her share, or her share to
the survivor or survivors of my said Children
I subject & overthrust and it is hereby
my express will Determination and appointment
that my beloved Husband Alexander M. Dyer
and Father of my said Children shall have the
sole and absolute control and direction of
said negroes and all property real and
-al which I may have at my death and
-ble of my bequest to and for the benefit
my said Children and that he should
particularity account to them or their
them

for the several Estates and Monies arising
from the said Negroes & other property but he
shall have it in his power during this life to apply
for their use and maintenance what proportion he
shall think most fit for them and in case any
of my said Daughters should not at any time
get married, I shall not in any way or by any
means impede my present Intention and appoint-
ment by compelling any How my said Husband to be
accountable to her or her Husband for the Affairs and
profits thereof, nor further than he shall think fit
or proper and also my wife in case a division of
Property should at any time take place for the
benefit of my said Children and with the Consent
of my said Husband who is hereby empowered to
order it Then I direct as the most proper and
fit persons to answer the End intended by such
Division, that my said Husband shall have the sole
management of the same and that such division
may be done and apportioned by him alone as
he shall in his discretion and Love for his Children
think just & Equitable and LASTLY I do hereby
nominate, constitute and appoint to be my Executors
Edward Telfair, & Thomas Netherclift, and I do
hereby enjoin and request them or either of them to
see that my present Will, Limitation, Testament
and Appointment, be fully Executed and Accomplish-
ed according to my wish and desire and the true
Intent and Meaning of these Presents and to em-
power and allow fully and freely my said Husband
the Authorities and Immunities I have hereby
delegated to him IN WITNESS whereof -
I have here to set my Hand & Seal this Twentieth
first day of October in the year of our Lord our three-
and thirtieth Hundred & thirtieth Year
