I Elizabeth Wallotton of the City of Savannah county & State
aforesaid do give and bequeath unto my son Jeremiah Wal-
lotton the following property herein after mentioned, first imme-
diately after my decease and all my lawful debts are paid
and funeral expenses discharged, it is my will that the aforesaid
Jeremiah Wallotton shall have the following negro
slaves, Duke and his wife Nell, and their children dimble
Patt and Kate, Bella and her children, Pia Edinburg, h,
Hannah and me and Joe, with all the future issue and
increase of the aforesaid female slaves. that he the aforesaid
Jeremiah Wallotton shall have and hold the aforesaid
negro slaves and their increase to him the said Jeremiah
Wallotton and to his only proper use and behoof and to his
heirs executors, administrators and assigns forever. Be it
hereby also known that an action was entered in the Court of
Equity in the State of South Carolina by James Wallotton and
Elizabeth Wallotton whose maiden name was Elizabeth Knott,
as heirs of Jeremiah Knott, against Humphrey Jones, for
a certain tract of land, which is to be found in the records
of State of South Carolina, & now as I have empowered Will^m
Patterson to use his utmost induavours to recover the land above
mentioned for which he the said William Patterson was to be
at all the expenses attendant thereon, and to have a half
of the said land when recovered, and the other half in reversion
for me the said Elizabeth Wallotton. I therefore give & bequeath
the one half of the aforesaid land when recovered, to my son
Jeremiah Wallotton, and that the said Jeremiah Wallotton
immediately after my death, shall be intitled to all my part-
thorough to him the said Jeremiah Wallotton and to his sole
use and proper behoof and to his heirs executors adminis-
trators and assigns, for ever. I give and bequeath to my
daughters Elizabeth Pender, Elizabeth Martin, Elizabeth Johnston, Eliza-
beth Stevens now Elizabeth Quinn the sum of one Federal
dollar. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Ann Wallot-
ton now Mrs Patterson the sum of one Federal dollar I give
and bequeath unto my daughter Henrietta Wallotton now Henrietta
Tutts the sum of one Federal dollar. Signed Sealed & delivered
in the presence of the Witnesses, who have put their names

I Mary Fraser of Port Royal Island in the
State aforesaid Widow do make declare and publish this
my last Will and Testament. that is to say. I give
devise and bequeath unto my beloved daughters Caroline
Ann Fraser, and Harriett Maria Fraser my tract of
land on Port Royal Island aforesaid called Springfield
whereon Mr John Richardson now resides, to them
and their heirs forever as tenants in common, but
in case either of my said daughters should marry
die without issue, or die unmarried, then and in such
case, I do give devise and bequeath the said tract of
land to the survivor of them, and to her heirs forever
forever. I do also give and bequeath unto my said
daughters all my furniture in my house in Port
Beils, bedding and bed linen, Table & table linen
Glass Household and Kitchen Furniture of every
kind, also all my table, dessert and tea spoons
milk pot cream and Sugar brackets, and
all of Silver, and lining the family chest, and
pot, also all my Horses, Carriages, Coach
