I Elizabeth Young of the County of Chatham aforesaid, Widow sick and weak in body, but of sound mind, memory and discretion, (paise be to God for it) and considering the certainty of Death and the uncertainty of the time thereof; and so the end I may be the better to leave this, when ever it shall please God to call me hence do therefore make and declare this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and annulling all former Will and Wills by me heretofore made (that is to say) first and principally I recommend my Soul to Almighty God my Creator; My body I commit to the earth, at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named; and as to my worldly Goods, I will and direct them to be disposed of in the manner following. I give and bequeath to my grand niece Mary C. Maxwell daughter of my nephew the late Thomas C. Maxwell and Mary his wife late Mary C. Maxwell the sum of Fifty Dollars. I give and bequeath to Saml. C. Maxwell son of the said Thomas C. Maxwell & Mary his wife the sum of One hundred Dollars. I give and bequeath to the Children of my nephew Simon Maxwell viz; Hannah & James

Alexander Maxwell and Mary Maxwell the sum of One hundred Dollars each.

Item. I give and bequath to my grand nephew John Maxwell son of Stephen John Butler Maxwell, the sum of Fifty Dollars.

Item I give and bequath to Maria Mc Intosh daughter of Mrs Mary Mc Intosh, late Mary Maxwell of Lunenburg the sum of Fifty Dollars.

Item, I give and bequath to my grand nephew John Stevens Maxwell, son of my late Nephew Moultrie Maxwell the sum of One Hundred Dollars.

Item, I give & bequath to my grand nephews, Richard Footman Henry Footman, William Footman & Edward Footman sons of my late niece Elizabeth late Elizabeth Caldwell the sum of Fifty Dollars each.

Item. I give and bequath to Mrs Mary Maxwell, widow of my late nephew Doctor John Maxwell, and her three children the sum of Two hundred and Fifty Dollars, to be divided between them.

Item. I give and bequath to the Children of my late nephew Stephen Maxwell, the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars to be equally divided between them share and share alike.

Item. I give and bequath to my Grand Niece Jane Eliza Pelot, daughter of the aforesaid James P Maxwell, the sum of One Hundred Dollars.

Item I give and bequath to my Grand Niece Esther or Betty Maxwell, daughter of the above named James P. Maxwell the sum of Fifty Dollars.

Item. I give and bequath, to my beloved niece Ellen or Nelly Hemming the sum of Fifty Dollars my Bible and my Gold Watch.

Item. I give and bequath to my beloved sister Constant Maxwell of Belfast all my Books, except the Bible as before bequathed.

Item I give and bequath to my grand Niece Susan Jefferson Maxwell, daughter of the aforesaid James P Maxwell, and Mary his wife, late Mary Taberham the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars to be held in trust, to and for the sole use, benefit & support

of the said Susan Jefferson Maxwell, by Thomas Young
and John Jackson Maxwell Esquires, and the Interest
of the same, to be paid annually into the hands of
Joseph S. Pilot, to be appropriated and applied, to the
education and support of the said Susan Jefferson
Maxwell, and in case of the Death of the said
Susan Jefferson Maxwell without lawful issue then
the said sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred
Dollars. to be equally divided between the aforesaid
Jane Eliza Pilot, Mary C. Maxwell, and James
Wabersham Maxwell, children of the aforesaid James
S. Maxwell, and in case of their or either of their
Deaths then to their lawful issue, share and share
alike. ~~~~

Item. All the rest and remainder of my Estate
whatssoever I give and bequath to the Children of
John Jackson Maxwell, to the Children of Simon
Maxwell, to the Children of David John Maxwell
to the Children of Stephen Maxwell, and to the
four eldest Children of Moultrie Maxwell aforesaid,
to have and to hold the same, to them and to their
Heirs forever, share and share alike. ~~~~

Lastly, I nominate & appoint Thomas Young & John
Jackson Maxwell Executors of this my last will & Tes-
tament. ~~~~
