to be equally divided between the heirs of her body
share and share alike to them and their heirs
and assigns forever

And lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and
appoint my daughter Catharine Executrix of this
my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all
former Wills by me made, declaring this to be
only to be my last Will and Testament And
testify whereunto I have set my hand & seal
this fourth day of October in the year of our
Lord One thousand eight hundred and ten
