former Wills by me made, declaring this to be  
only to be my last Will and Testament And  
although wherunto I have set my hand & seal  
this fourth day of October in the year of our  
Lord One thousand eight hundred and ten

& declared by the Testatrix  
to be her last Will and Ann Rosannah Winecoff
