(one) shall pay to Lot No. 2. (two) the sum of one hundred & fifty Dollars to make the said division fair & equal, all which is certified by us, pursuant to the order of Court and oath hereto annexed, authorising us to make said division. The Lots No. one & two remain undivided for the use of John Morel & Henry Morel. Given under our hands and seals this seventeenth day of January in the year of our Lords one thousand eight hundred & fifteen

Whereas it has been represented to the hon-
 ourable the court of Ordinary of Chatham County.

by Francis H. McLeod in right of his wife Mary
McLeod Ann Millen & Metheca M. Jones, persons
entitled to the estate of John Millen late of Chat-
ham County planter deceased, that the said John
Millen died possessed of a tract of land in the County
of Chatham two lots in the City of Savannah, ne-
groes and other personal property, and that the said
Francis H. McLeod in right of his wife Mary Mc-
Leod Ann Millen & Metheca Jones possess the
said tract of Land in the County of Chatham, two
lots in the City of Savannah negroes and other person-
al property, the said land, lots negroes and other
personal property being the undivided estate of the
said John Millen deceased. And whereas it has
also been represented that Francis H. McLeod in right
of his wife Mary McLeod, Ann Millen & Metheca Jones
are the only persons entitled to the said estate of John Mil-
len deceased, and are desirous of having the said land
lots, negroes and other personal property divided between
themselves, and that their respective portions may be
appropriated to them agreeable to the provisions con-
tained in the act of Assembly in such cases made
and provided. We are therefore to require & command
you the said George W. McAllister, George Lewis Coker,
Adam Cope, Stephen S. Williams & Robert Habersham
that in your proper persons you appear to the Land
and lots following, that is to say, One tract of
Land in the district of Little Ogeechee & County of
Chatham containing three hundred & twenty acres
of which about one hundred & fifty acres are inland
Swamp of the second quality, one hundred & twenty
mixed pine & oak bounded north by lands of Jones
& Telfair, South by land of Williams, East by George
Millen, land and west by lands of Jones & Telfair.
A Lot in the City of Savannah known by the name of
one (1.) Belcher Tything Heathcoat Ward, and also
of Land also in the City Savannah known by the name of
four (4.) Four Tything, Decker Ward, negroes and
negroes and other personal property, and in the
presence of the parties, their agents, or others.

or guardians by you to be warned if they will be present you do cause to be divided & partitioned off the said tract of Land and lots of Land abovementioned and also the negroes and other personal property of the said John Millen deceased into three equal parts (due respect being had to the value of each part) and the same being so divided you shall cause one third part thereof with the appurtenances to be delivered to Francis H. M. Leod in right of his wife Mary M. Leod, one third thereof to be delivered to Ann Millen and the remaining third part thereof to be delivered to Hester Jones to be held by them in severally so that neither of the said parties have more of the said estate than to him or her of right belongeth: and the said partition so by you or a majority of you made as aforesaid under your hands & seals or the hands & seals of a majority of you have you before the honourable the Court of Ordinary of Chatham County in Savannah within three months from the date hereof together with this writ
