I Gavin Scott of the City of Savannah County
of Chatham and State aforesaid Chair Maker, being in good
health of body and of sound mind and memory, but from
the certainty of Death and uncertainty of life, do make
this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all
former Wills or Testaments made by or for me in any
manner whatever

First 307 It is my Will and request to my Executors
named that my funeral be plain and decent

my General Expenses and all my just debts be punctually paid.

Secondly I have bequeath and devise unto my beloved sister Jane Scott of the City of Glasgow in the Kingdom of Scotland all the remainder and residue of my Estate, whether the same be real or personal, particularly the following negro Slaves, Sack, Glasgow, and Anne, together with the future increase and issue of the said family Slave Anne. Also all those Buildings and the proceeds profits issues and rents thereof. Situated in the City of Savannah in the County of Chatham (State of Georgia) and the South East corner of Mr. Tilly Lot, bounding South on St. Julian Street and East on Jefferson Street, and also all and singular whatever the property I may die possessed of whether the same shall consist of money goods or Chattels or any kind of Real or personal Estate whatsoever or otherwise, and should the said Jane Scott die without issue it is my will that the whole of my Estate shall devolve to my brother or his heirs or to my next nearest of kin who maybe the Survivor or Survivors.

Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my trusty friends Robert Fair Shor maker and Thomas Williams, Mariners both of the City of Savannah my Executors to fulfill the true intent and meaning of this my last Will and Testament, In Witness whereof I have hereunto signed my name & affixed my Seal
