wife Lydia Myers the whole of the estate & property
that I may die possessed of be the same real, personal
or of any other kind / except a mulatto slave named
(Rose) to have and to hold unto that said Lydia Myers
the said estate & property herein before mentioned for &
during the term of her natural life

Thirdly, I give devise & bequeath unto my son Thomas
his heirs and assigns, a mulatto slave named Rose
which he has had for some time past

Lastly, After the death of my wife Lydia Myers I give
all the estate I die possessed of & which is herein before
given to her during her life unto my son George Myers
his heirs & assigns. - And I revoke all former wills by
me made & hereby appoint my son George Myers, sole
executor of this my last will ~~at Savannah~~ Savannah
