At a District Court held at the
Capitol in the City of Richmond the Ninth day
of April 1808 -

This last Will and Testament
of James Gunn deceased was presented in Court
and proved by the oath of Francis Howard a witness
thereto and David Lambert and John S. Gunn
being sworn severally deposed that they were
well acquainted with the Testator's Hand writing
and verily believe that the said Will and his name
therein subscribed are wholly written by the Testator
own hand - Whereupon the said Will was ordered
to be recorded - and at a District Court held
at the Capitol aforesaid the twentieth day of
the same month - On the motion of Sarah Gunn
the Executrix named in the said last Will and
Testament who made oath thereto according to law
and with John Adams David Lambert and
John [unclear] called into & acknowledged

a bond in the penalty of Ten thousand Dollars
conditioned as the law directs. Certificate was
granted to the said Sarah for obtaining a
probate of the said will in due form.
