hereby making null and void all former wills Deeds
gifts and bequests so First I commit my soul to my
dear Lord Jesus Christ who hath loved me and
washed me from my sins in his own Blood and though
whom alone I hope for an admittance into his eternal
glory. First I give and bequeath unto my dear brother
James Crane of St. Mary Astington in the County
of Middlesex the sum of Ten pounds Sterling money
of Great Britain. Item I give and bequeath unto Mrs.
Sarah Cleaver of the Parish aforesaid the sum of One
Guinea. Item I give and bequeath unto Mr. Joseph
Baron in the Parish of Clarkenwell in the County
aforesaid, the sum of One Guinea. Item I give
and bequeath unto John Perry the sum of one
guinea. Item I give and bequeath unto Mr. John
Groves the sum of one guinea. Item I give and
bequeath unto Mrs. Elizabeth Wood the sum of one
guinea. Item I give and bequeath unto each of
the Poor living in the late Rev'd Mr. George White's
fields Chappel yard in Tottenham Court Road, the
sum of Twenty Shillings. Lastly I give and bequeath
unto the Rev'd Thomas Hill with whom I now live
all my real and personal Estate dues and Debts
whatever that may be remaining after the payment
of my just Debts & Funeral Expenses and the legacies
as aforesaid. Lastly I nominate and appoint Mr.
aforesaid Thomas Hill to be my Sole and only
Executor to this my last will and Testament
given under my hand and Seal this twenty
day of November in the year of our Lord One
thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty
and in the Eighth year of our Independence

Georgia } Whereas I Jane Cochran wife of
James Cochran Esquire, was heretofore in
my own right and, previous to my Marriage, proprietor
of the following Negroes namely, Toby, Doll, Jenny,
Tom Sally, Linda, Delia, Dick, Hannah, Maria
Phillis, Andrew, Wilks, Peg, Bristol, Henry, Pame-
la, Will, Sina, Boatswain and Adams, and
also in possession of a Plantation on Little
Ogeechee Containing Two Hundred and Ninety Acres, or
thereabouts, with a Stock of Horses and Cattle. And
Whereas in and by Certain Marriage Articles, made
and entered into Between me the said Jane, heretofore
Jane Delagall, the said James Cochran, and
Josiah McLean a trustee bearing date the Twenty
fourth day of June one thousand seven hundred
and Eighty three, it is amongst other things there
agreed upon and stipulated Between the Contracting
parties in these words "And it is further pro-
vided upon the Special Trust and Confidence herein
Created expressed and declared that should the
said Jane Delagall during the Concourse with her
said intended Husband James Cochran, die at
this life, in that Case, the said Josiah McLean and
his Heirs shall Stand Seized of one Moeny in Value
of the above Mentioned Negroes and their posterity
and increase and affar of the aforescore Trust and
or Plantation on Little Ogeechee to the only pur-
pose and behoof of such Person or Persons as
Jane shall by her last will and testam-
ent bequeath or Give the same to, provided also
that no will or Testament to be made or found
the powers herein reserved by the said Jane
shall intend, or be construed to extend
the said James Cochran with his
Mony of Negroes and their posterity
and increase and of the aforescore Trust and
