aforesaid. Planter, being of sound mind memory and
understanding, but taking into view the uncertainty of
human life do make and ordain this my last will and
Testament in manner & form following, that is to say

First I commit my soul to God who gave it, in full confidence
of future happiness thro the merits and mediation of the
the deemer of Mankind.

Secondly I give and bequeath unto my sisters Louisa & Charlotte to
them and to their heirs forever all my right title or claim
to my Estate known by the name of DeVillars near the
City of Viney, or of whatsoever Estate I now am or shall
hereafter be possessed of in Viney.

Thirdly I give and bequeath to Mr. William B Fox in fee simple
all that tract or parcel of land, known by the name
of Matthew Mawri's Old fields, which he at present occu-
pies, agreeable to a lease he now has from me

Fourthly I give and bequeath to James B Courvoisier Fox son of James
Fox, the sum of One thousand five hundred Dollars to be
paid to him when he shall arrive at the age of twenty
one years.

Fifthly I give and bequeath to Mary Ann Fox daughter of William
B Fox the sum of Five hundred Dollars.

Sixthly I give and bequeath to my Sisters Louisa & Charlotte
the sum of two thousand Dollars provided they should
claim the same, or stand in need thereof.

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Courvoisier
her heirs and assigns forever, my servant Maria Lucy
and her son Abraham, with a choice of any two other
servants that I may be possessed of.

Item I give and bequeath to my Grand daughter Mary Fox
Courvoisier in fee simple my two negro girls, Charlotte
and Amelia.

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary to her
her heirs forever the one half or moiety of all my
Estate be it real or Personal.

Item I give and bequeath to my son John

and his male heirs forever, the remaining half or moiety of my Estate Real or Personal, and in Case my Son John should die without Male issue, then if my Wife should survive him, his moiety of the Estate I give and bequeath to her which said moiety in Case of the death of my Wife shall vest, and I do hereby give the same to the nearest Relation by my Mothers side.

Item I give and bequeath to my friend Charles Harris Esquire my double eared Gold watch, and my Gold headed Cane which I beg he will accept as a token of that Friendship that subsisted between us while living

And I do hereby nominate, constitute, and appoint my beloved Wife Mary Courvoisie and my friend Charles Harris Esquire of the State and County aforesaid to be my Executors and Executor of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking, annulling and declaring void all other and former Wills by me heretofore made and executed. In testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal at Savannah this twenty seventh day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten.
