In the name of God amen. I, John Harbock of the State
& County aforesaid, being weak in body but of sound
mind memory & understanding do make & publish this my
last will and testament in manner & form following
to wit. Item first. It is my will & desire to be decently
interred. Item second. I give and bequeath to James
Boyd of Chatham County all my property real & person-
al of which I may die possessed of, to him and his
heirs for ever. Item third. I also constitute James Boyd
& Patrick Duffy, my executors to see this my last will &
testament carried into effect. Made, signed & published
& declared in presence of us this twenty third day of
March, one thousand eight hundred & fourteen. & in
thirty eighth year of American Independence

the time of the execution thereof and that they all sub-
scribed their names as witnesses thereto in the presence
of the said Testator and at his request and in the pres-
ence of each other.
