& my mind & understanding, under divine Provi-
dence correct, Calling to mind that, in the last
Will & Testament, I made & executed, whilst in
England, one Copy of which, was left with my
Brother in Law, the Rev^d Thomas Bennet & one
other with W^m. Bell Esq^r of Russell Square in London
that I have omitted to name in the said Will.
Executors thereof, to carry my devises & intentions
into effect resident here, where my property is
Principally concentrated, I do therefore, by this
Codicil confirm in every part & section any
devise legacy or Trust named therein, & do by this
Codicil to be taken as part of my said Will. Con-
stitute & appoint my friends William Stephens, D. B.
Mutchell & Tho^s Shalading Esquires executors of my
said Will so far as relates to my Property in this
Country. In Case of my sudden dissolution, I request
& desire that my Red leather pocket book with an
Pad lock thereto, which is in the drawer of my
writing Desk, be delivered as directed to my friend
W^m Stephens. In Witness whereof I have to this
Codicil written in my own hand writing, set my
hand & Seal, this the Ninth day of April in the
Year of our Lord 1808.
