Item, I give and bequeath all my personal property in the City of Savannah embracing sundry negroes, with all my household furniture and utensils in and belonging to my Mansion house at my death, also my part of Silver plate left by my mother to be divided in equal between me and my brother George & Alex^r Fraser

Item I further give devise and bequeath all the interest I have in the real and personal property of Richard Ruple Ash of South Carolina deceased, which interest I claim by his last Will and testament, also all the interest I claim (as Kin) to the real and personal estate of my Brother William Fraser and sister Caroline Fraser both of South Carolina deceased. And

Lastly I do hereby constitute nominate and appoint my dear and beloved wife Caroline Fraser to be sole executrix of this my last Will and testament, at the same time it is my wish that she would employ some discreet Attorney to aid her in settling my temporal concerns. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand, and affixed my seal this fifteenth day of May Eighteen hundred and sixteen

and possessed of, or entitled unto, To have and to hold
my estate given devised and bequeathed as aforesaid
to her the said Mary D. Bowen by her executors ad-
ministrators and assigns forever. And I do nominate the
said Mary D. Bowen to be sole executrix of this my
last Will and testament, revoking all other former
Wills by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereto
set my hand & Seal this twenty sixth day of April in
the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and
