I give and bequeath to my grand niece Mary Maxwell daughter of my nephew the late Thomas P. Maxwell and Mary his late Mary's daughter the sum of Fifty Dollars. I give and bequeath to Saml. Trubshaw the son of the said James P. Maxwell & Maria his wife the sum of One hundred Dollars. I give and bequeath to the Children of my nephew Simons Maxwell viz; Hannah & Maria
