

The above Lots having been made and valued the portion and lot number three (No. 3) was drawn and fell to the share of Mr. Thomas Vethercliff - Morel consisting of the following negroes. to wit, Manny, Jacko or Ned, Patty, Thaddeus, Titus, - Rynah, Saphana, Nancy, Pompey, Molly, Prince, Old Tom, Bess, Diana, Jerry, Tom, Siloh, David, Katy, Brutus Molly, Sandy, Peter, Morea, Chloce, Peg, March, Bella, Winifred, Cato, Punch Betty Phillis, Lydia, Aggy, William, Gift & Die, which said negroes and the future issue and increase of the said female slaves we allot as the share and proportion of the said Thomas Vethercliff Morel his executors administrators & assigns as ordered by the Court and we further order that Lot No. 1. (one) shall pay to Lot No. 2. (two) the sum of one hundred & fifty Dollars to make the said division fair & equal, all which is certified by us, pursuant to the order of Court and oath hereto annexed, authorising us to make said division. The Lots No. one & two remain undivided for the use of John Morel & Henry Morel. Given under our hands and seals this seventeenth day of January in the year of our Lords one thousand eight hundred & fifteen

lots in the City of Savannah, negroes and other person-
al property, the said land, lots, negroes and other
personal property being the undivided estate of the
said John Millett deceased. And whereas it has
also been represented that Francis H. McLeod in right
of his wife Mary McLeod Ann Millett & Methea Jones
are the only persons entitled to the said estate of John Mil-
lett deceased, and are desirous of having the said land,
lots, negroes and other personal property divided between
themselves, and that their respective portions may be
appropriated to them agreeable to the provisions con-
tained in the act of Assembly in such cases made

that in your proper persons you repair to the land
and lots following, that is to say, One tract of

mixed pine & oak bounded north by lands of Jones
& Telfair, South by land of Bellows, East by George
Millett's land and west by lands of Jones & Telfair.
