I John Tebeau of the City of Savannah in the
County of Chatham State of Georgia, Planter being
of sound mind and understanding and consider-
ing the uncertainty of Human life Do make this
my last Will and Testament as follows (that
is to say) As to the ordering of my funeral I
leave it entirely to the discretion of my Execu-
tors hereinafter mentioned to be performed in
any manner consistent with decency & Respect -
I Give devise and bequeath to my dear wife
Catherine Tebeau during her natural life
all my Estate real and personal of every kind and
description whatever and where soever - But it
is my will and I do hereby charge my said
Estate and direct and order my said wife Cath-
erine to Educate and maintain out of the proceeds
and profits of the same such of my Children as
may be unmarried at the time of my death and
until they shall respectively marry - And it is
my further will and I do hereby (John Tebeau)
further direct and order that in case my said
wife Catherine Tebeau shall depart this life before
all my said Children shall have attained the age of
Twenty one Year or have intermarried then and in that
Case my said Estate real & personal shall be kept
together and worked to the best advantage and the
proceeds and profits thereof or so much as may be
necessary applied to the education and maintenance
of such of my Children as may be under the age
of Twenty one Year and unmarried - And upon
the death of my said wife Catherine and when
my Children shall have intermarried or attained
the age of Twenty one years Then I Give devise
and bequeath all my said Estate real and
personal to my Children and to their heirs and
for ever the same to be equally divided among
Shaw and Shaw alike but in Case of the death
of either of them before the other shall have
attained the age of Twenty one years then the
share of the deceased shall be added to the share
of the survivor to be equally divided among the
survivors.

And I do nominate and appoint my said wife
Catherine Tebean and my sons Frederick Edmond
Tebean and Charles Watson Tebean Executors &
Executrix of this my will, And I do hereby revoke
all wills at any time heretofore by me made and
declare this only to be my last will and Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
Seal at Savannah this Thirtieth day of April
in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
seven.
