Planter —

First I will and direct that my Negroes Horses Stock  
and other property now on the Plantation where I reside  
may be kept and continued there together untill the Crop  
which is now growing shall be made and gathered for  
market, and I also will and direct that my just  
Debts shall be paid with the proceeds of the Crop —  
and if my wife Barbara Boyde should be inclined to  
remain and reside at the said Plantation I wish to  
request that my son Charles would permit her to do  
so as long as she pleases — Also I give and be-  
queath to my son Charles Boyde my Negro woman Lucy  
and my mare —

Also I give and bequeath to my son James Boyde  
my Negro boy ~~and my~~ (the said Wench) and my young
