liams of the County & State aforesaid being weak in body but of
sound mind & memory, blessed be Almighty God for the same
throwing the uncertainty of this life, do make public and
declare this my last will & testament in manner & form fol-
lowing, that is to say. Item 1st. I give and bequeath to
my beloved friend Henry Piper one equal proportion of all
moneys which may be due to me by the United States
as a seaman on board the U. S. Ship Essex, Captain Porter for ser-
vices performed on board said ship.

- Item 2. I give and bequeath to my beloved friend Jack Scott
one equal proportion of all such moneys as may be due me
3. as aforesaid. Item 3^d. I give and bequeath to my beloved
friend William Gilbert one equal proportion of all such
4. moneys as may be due me as aforesaid. Item 4th. I
give and bequeath to my beloved friend Joseph Dixon one
equal proportion of all such moneys as may be due to me
5. as aforesaid. Item 5th. I give and bequeath to my beloved
friend Charles Sameison one equal proportion of all such
moneys as may be due me as aforesaid. Item 6th. I give
6. and bequeath to my beloved friend James W. Stewart one
equal proportion of all such moneys as may be due me as aforesaid.
7. Item 7th. I give and bequeath to my beloved friend Thomas
Carlton one equal proportion of all such moneys as may
be due me as aforesaid share and share alike. Item 8th.
8. It is my wish that before these said legacies are paid
my executor herein after named upon receipt of the amount
of sums of money due to me as a seaman on board
the late U. S. Ship Essex do pay all the just demands
which may be against me in the City of Savannah.
9. Item 9th. I do hereby appoint my friend James
to be my executor to this my last will and testament
authorising him to demand from the persons
pay as aforesaid & when satisfied to distribute the same

among the several persons above named after the pay-
ment of all my just debts. In witness whereof I the said
Jordan Williams have hereunto set my hand & seal at,
Savannah the twenty sixth day of September in the
year eighteen hundred & fourteenth.
