In the name of God Amen! I Joseph Dawson of the County and State aforesaid being in a low state of health but sound in mind, do acknowledge this as my last will and testament. I hereby certify that my brother John Dawson & James Roberts are my whole & sole Executors and do injoin on them to see this will strictly and faithfully executed.

I do will and bequeath as follows. To my nieces Mary, Elizabeth and Martha Shereman daughters of my sister Elizabeth my two negroes Affy and Jack and their issue, and in case of the death of the aforesaid children or their issue, if no issue of their body, the said negroes Affy and Jack and their issue to return back to my brothers John & Thomas Dawson and James Roberts & their heirs for ever. My watch I bequeath to my brother John Dawson, my gun to Thomas Dawson my wearing apparel to my brother Richard Dawson and my household furniture to be divided between my brothers Thomas & James, my landed estate I will and bequeath to my nephew Joseph Humbert youngest son of William Humbert by my sister Esther but in case of the death of the aforesaid Joseph Humbert all my landed estate to return back to my brothers John & Thomas and their heirs for ever. It is my further wish that the moneys now due me may be appropriated in part to the purchasing of lumber should Mrs. Mein be disposed to sell her she to go to the use and benefit of the aforesaid children. The residue I wish laid out in Bank shares the profits arising therefrom to go to the use of the children also.
