First. It is my Will and desire that all and every kind of my Estate both real and personal of every kind or nature whatsoever be publicly advertised and sold at twelve months Credit by my

Executors hereinafter named, and the money arising from the same be equally divided between the Heirs of the body of Martha Hollinger or such of them as may be alive, which I give and bequeath all the afore mentioned Money that may arise from such sale unto Sally, William, Murriah and Sinia Hollinger, the Heirs of said Martha Hollinger of said State and County aforesaid to them & their heirs forever.

Secondly It is my Will and desire that any of the above named Sally, William, Murriah or Sinia Hollinger may be under age, to receive their equal share of the Money such as my Estate may fetch by reason of such sale being made as above Be put out at Interest for the purpose of educating of them. I do hereby nominate and appoint my true and well beloved friends Reason Davis and Martha Hollinger, both of the aforesaid County and State aforesaid, to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament, Revoking all other Wills by me hereto afore made, And declaring this to be my last and only Will and Testament, dated this fourth Day of January 1811.
