negro slaves shown to us, as belonging to the estate of  
the said Joseph P. Holmes and having taken the oath  
prescribed by law and having notified the parties con-

we did proceed to make a division of the said slaves

Riah being lot number four And for the purpose  
of equalizing the said several lots Wids further direct  
that David Taylor in behalf of his children do pay the  
sums of money following viz To Mrs. Elizabeth Holmes  
the sum of Eighty Seven Dollars & fifty cents To the Rev.  
Charles Scirven for the children of the late David G. Holmes  
the sum of One Hundred & thirty Seven Dollars & fifty cents  
and to Miss Mary M. Holmes the sum of Eighty Seven  
Dollars and fifty cents by reason whereof the lot of the child  
ren of the said David Taylor which was valued at  
Twenty One Hundred & fifty Dollars will be reduced to  
Eighteen Hundred & Thirty Seven Dollars & fifty Cents &  
the lot of the said Elizabeth Holmes which was valued  
at Seventeen Hundred & fifty Dollars and the lot of  
the children of the said David G. Holmes which was  
valued at Seventeen Hundred Dollars and the lot  
of the said Mary M. Holmes which was valued at
