

In the name of God amen.

I Justus Hulst of the City of Savannah and County of Chatham being sick and weak in body, but of sound mind memory and understanding Do make and publish this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following to wit:

First of all I give and bequeath to my Wife Hannah Hulst. The House and Lot now owned and occupied by me, Situate in the City of Savannah Deckerboro on Broughton Street, for and during her natural life, then immediately after her death to the heirs of her body lawfully begotten should there be any living at the time of her death, by heirs is meant the children of the said Hannah Hulst, If no such heirs then and in that case the property so vested as aforesaid shall revert to and be vested in the children of my brother George Hulst and Samuel Hulst, and in the children of my sisters Mary, Experience, and Amy, Sarah and Sarah alike.

Also I give and bequeath to my Wife Hannah Hulst all my House hold and Kitchen furniture, together with all my House hold goods.

Also I give and bequeath to my Wife Hannah Hulst, all my negro slaves.

Also I give and bequeath to my Wife Hannah Hulst One thousand Dollars specie to be paid her immediately after my death.

Also I give and bequeath to my Sister Nancy Hulst five hundred Dollars to be paid her within nine months after my death.

Also I direct that all my property not herein before bequeathed that shall remain after the payment of all my just debts, be placed in the hands of my Father Justus Hulst of the State of New York if he shall be living at the time of my death, if not the same to be placed in the hands of my brother Daniel Hulst, for the sole and separate use of all the children that now are or may hereafter be born of my brothers & sisters hereinbefore mentioned, the property so placed to be vested in Bank Stock, and the interest arising thereon, to be drawn for in the name of my Father

Justus Hulse or in the name of such other person or persons as a majority of my Brothers and Sisters herein before named shall nominate and appoint, which Interest so drawn as aforesaid shall be for the uses and benefit of the Children of my Brothers & Sisters herein before named.

And I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife Hannah Hulse Executrix, and Patrick Duffy and John Tillman both of Savannah Executors of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Will or Wills by me heretofore made. And I do further request that the Executors herein before named, will erect a suitable Brick Vault, and that my remains be interred therein.
