interred and for such worldly estate as I am possessed
of (after full payment of all my just debts and funeral
expences) I give and dispose of as follows -

Item. I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife,
Jane Achord, one small Bay horse, riding Chair and
harness. Also all my house hold & kitchen furniture
forever, to be at her own disposal as she may think
fit - It is also my wish that all the estate which
may be left after complying with the above shall be
kept together in like manner as shall be mentioned
hereafter. Item. I give and bequeath unto my be-
loved wife Jane during her natural life, the full use
and charge of all my real and personal property, to be
in such manner as she may deem best for the benefit
of my fore named children, which is as follows. My
son Lewis D. Achord, my daughter Ann Achord, my son
John S. Achord, and my daughter Jane Achord; and
at the decease of my beloved wife Jane Achord, it is
my wish that should there be any estate before any
division shall take place, that my daughter Ann A-
chord shall pick two such cows as she may wish af-
ter that all the property which may be left shall be
equally divided among my four above named children
share and share alike - And further I do hereby nomi-
nate, constitute and appoint my beloved wife Jane
Achord, Executor and my son Lewis D. Achord, Co-
executor, of this my last Will and Testament, hereby
revoking and making null and void all other Wills
by me heretofore made. In Testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th day of February, in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and sixteen.

100 Hundred dollars, to be paid, if living in twelve months after my decease. The rest, residue and remainder of my real and personal estate, of whatever name and nature, I give, devise and bequeath unto my truly and well beloved sister Abigail Silsby, to hold to her and her heirs and assigns forever. And I hereby constitute and appoint David Shillaber of said Boston, Trader, and Charles Harris, of Savannah, in the state of Georgia, Exors. Executors of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Will or Wills heretofore by me made. And I do declare this to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have herunto set my hand and seal, this twenty sixth day of August, Anno Domini, One thousand eight hundred and eight.
