I Lucas Lucena of the City of Savannah Butcher being of indifferent health but of sound memory & understanding, and fully sensible of the true dispensations of a just and merciful creator, do make publish and declare these presents, to be and contain my last Will and Testament.

- First All my lawfull debts and funeral charges to be paid from such estate as I may die possessed of
- Secondly I leave and bequeath to my four daughters namely Suckey, Hannah, Isabella, and Jane when they respectively arrive at mature age, to each of them five hundred dollars, to be paid in Cash by my son Thomas Lucena who at this time resides in Charleston in the State of South Carolina; he the said Thomas maintaining and supporting them in as comfortable and genteel a manner as he may deem necessary and proper, until they respectively arrive at maturity as above mentioned; and it is also my wish and desire that they shall receive from and through him such share of education as he may deem proper and necessary; after which he shall be at liberty to extend to or withhold from my four daughters aforesaid at his pleasure such further favours as they or any of them may require at his hands; all of which it is my will and desire shall be defrayed out of the Estate aforesaid and also that each of the legacies above mentioned shall be paid to the four heirs as above named without deduction or abatement, and that two in hand to my daughter Nancy who in consequence of her imprudent marriage with John Moxed very much displeased me I have and bequeath One Dollar
- Thirdly It is my particular Will and desire that my son Thomas shall have it fully at his option to give to my son John as much or as little of the said estate as he shall or may think proper according to desert; and in case the said John shall persist and continue in his improper conduct toward in that case I leave and bequeath to him the sum of One Dollar
- Fourthly After the foregoing dispositions I give and bequeath my whole estate real and personal of what other person owes to my dear son Thomas aforesaid.

Seventhly In consideration of the good and faithful services of my
dear Woman James it is my will and desire after her
death she shall be placed under my son Thomas ^{and}
for the term of two years, during which term she shall
be every way in his power servicable in the care and manage-
ment of my two youngest daughters Isabella and Jane ^{as}
said; at the expiration of which term of two years It is my will
and desire that she shall be manumitted and let free
Eighthly In case of the death of my son Thomas or any of my four
daughters Turkey, Hannah, Isabella and Jane as aforesaid
then and in that case it is my will and desire that
the part of him or her so dying shall fall to the
survivors or survivor and that this clause shall be
understood to relate merely to those of my children
viz Thomas, Turkey, Hannah, Isabella and Jane as aforesaid
(the name enterlined between the second and third lines of
this side of the sheet having been before omitted)

Ninthly I nominate and appoint my worthy and truly respectable
friend and fellow Citizen Doctor William Parker of Savan-
nah; and my son Thomas aforesaid, the lawful Executors
to this my last will and Testament, and request of
them to undertake the burthen of seeing these my last
wishes complied with, Savannah seventeenth day of July in
the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and
five, and of the Independence of the United States of
America the twenty ninth.
