

Georgia } I Michael Vermaire, being of sound mind,
 the law in my Body, do make by my Last
 Will and Testament, I give and bequeath, unto my beloved daughter
 Ann, Amelia Vermaire, all the real, and personal Estate of which
 I am seized, to her, and the heirs, a burg of her Behn lawfully begot
 here, or should she marry, and do leave her husband, without is-
 sue, to her and her heirs, or assigns I give, and bequeath, the above
 real Estate, known, as Spring, with the following exceptions;
 that is to say, out of my said Estate, I do hereby give and bequeath
 two hundred and fifty Dollars to the Baptist Church in Savannah,
 for their now proper use and benefit, and I give and bequeath here
 likewise, and fifty Dollars to said Church in trust, for the sole use
 and benefit of Mount Zion College. But should my said Daughter
 Ann, Amelia, Vermaire, die without Lawfull Issue, or a law-
 full husband, in that case, I give and bequeath all my real and
 personal Estate, with the single exception of the two hundred and
 fifty Dollars above given and bequeathed to the Baptist Church in Savannah
 in trust, for the sole use and benefit of Mount Zion College.
 And I do hereby nominate, and appoint my true and trusty friend,
 Thomas T. Williams, my Executor and my beloved daughter, above
 mentioned, my Executrix, to execute this my last Will and Testament.
