Georgia } This is the Last Will and
Chatham County } Testament of me Nathaniel
Adams, Senr of the district of Whitebluff State
and County aforesaid. I hereby Confirm to my
Son Nathl Adams Junr a deed made to him
dated twenty fourth Jan^y. one thousand seven
hundred & ninety nine for the plantation on
which he at present resides with the negroes therein
mention'd together with each and every other
property therein specified. To my Son Thomas
Adams I hereby give and bequeath the Three
hundred Acres of Land with the improvements
thereon be the same more or less, purchased by me
of Pullingar & Webley adjoining lands of
Michael Densler and the estate of Elbert.
The Plantation on which I present reside I leave
to my wife Ann Adams during her life and at
her decease to be divided between my daughters
Margaret & Susan Adams. My House and Lot
in City of Savannah I also leave to my said
Daughters Margaret and Susan Adams. But in
Case of failure of Crops or any accident happening
to prevent the payment of all my Just debts -
It is my wish that the said House and Lot in
Savannah towards paying off said demands
against me. To my wife Ann Adams I give
the Lot at the Village of Vernonburgh known
by the number three. After the payment of
all my Just Debts and my Personal

and other property not before mentioned in
 equal divisions between my wife Ann Adams
 my son Thomas Adams and my daughter Margaret
 and Susan Adams to be equally shared between
 each of them In Case of the death of either of my
 Children without Lawfull heirs it is my wish
 that whatever property is left them should be
 equally divided say the Personal property
 between my other Children including in the
 division my son Nathaniel Adams who shall
 receive an equal share in the division - I
 hereby constitute and appoint my wife Ann
 Adams Executrix and my son Nathaniel
 Adams Junr and William M Evans my Executors
 to this my last Will and Testament carried into
 full Execution dated signed sealed this seventh
 day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand
 Eight hundred & six in the Thirtieth Year of
 American Independence.
