Esquire being of sound and disposing mind memory
and understanding but considering the uncertainty
of this transitory life do Publish and declare
this my Last Will and Testament hereby 1810.
King and declaring void all and every other
Will and Wills by me heretofore made I com-
mend my soul to God who gave it me in the
humble hope of a happy resurrection through
the merits and mediation of our blessed Lord
Jesus Christ — It is my request if I die in
the Island of New Providence that my remains
may be decently interred in some convenient
part of my lot — and as to the worldly Estate
of which I may die proposed either in the Ba-
shams or in the hands of Chambers Langston Esq.
of London and Thomas & John Stoops of Liverpool
and the residue after payment of the legacies
herein after mentioned to my beloved wife Ann
Hale — also all my household furniture
Plates, Carriages & Horses — To my sister Sarah
Powell, to each of my brothers who may be living
at the time of my Death to my nephews George
Webb Hale and Samuel Hale Esq. of Bristol
and to my friends Josiah Battaille, Dr. Esq.
Thomas Gorbe, — William Telfair, Mr. Morton Dyer
& John Armstrong Esq. I bequeath the sum
of Five Guineas each for a ring — To Mather
Hale of Allister Esq. I give and bequeath a ser-
vant named Polydore and to his sister Hannah a ser-
vant a negro boy named Archer & then and
to their heirs forever — To the following named
Domestics, Bristol Miss. Peter Morris Young
Lucy Rhina I bequeath a decent suit of clothes
and five dollars each as a small legacy
of my regard for them as good and useful ser-
vants, and in full confidence that they will
turne to their Master — To the Chur-
ch and Vestry of the Parish of the
St. Matthew

to each Parish to be distributed at their discretion amongst such indigent Persons as may stand most in need thereof at the time of my death after payment of my debts (which I trust will be very trifling) and the aforesaid Legacies - I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved wife Ann Hale the rest residue and remainder of all my Estate & Property Real & Personal of what nature or quality whatsoever - the same may be or wheresoever situated being as being in the Bahamas Islands America or elsewhere to have and occupy a proper and enjoy the same and every part or Parcel thereof of the same to and for her use benefit & behoof for and during the time of her natural life with power and liberty to remove the personal property at her pleasure - Item, after the death of my aforesaid beloved wife I give devise and bequeath all and singular my aforesaid Estate & Property of every kind and description whatsoever to my Executrix herein after named and to the Survivor and last survivor of the and to the Heirs, Executrix and Administrators and assigns of such last survivor to for the uses and upon the trust herein after mentioned and declared of and concerning the same That is to say In Trust that they apply and pay one moiety or part thereof according to the value in such manner and to such purposes as my aforesaid beloved wife by her last Will and Testament or by any other deed instrument in writing under her hand & Seal & made in presence of Two or more creditable witness shall direct and appoint, and as to the other part or moiety thereof In trust that the same be disposed of still to the best advantage, and the monies arising from the sale thereof be applied, paid and disposed of in manner and form following That is to say Equally divided amongst such of my nephews & nieces - Children of my Brothers & Sisters as may then be living & have & share also the Legacies to be paid out of the money in the hands of my agents in England And I request that the construction which may at any time be given to this may be plain

evident and natural and that no refinement
may be made use of to destroy my intention
And of this my Last Will and Testament
I constitute my aforesaid beloved wife to be
Executor my Brother Joseph Hale of the City
of Bristol. My friends John Armstrong of
New Providence Esq^r, & Mathew McAllister
Esq^r of America to be my Executors. On
Wednesday whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & seal in the Town of Massaw the
Twenty ninth day of July in the Year of our
Lord one thousand Eight hundred & six and
in the Forty fifth Year of his Majesty's
reign

And it is possible from the ill health with
which she has for some time been afflicted
that she may die before me without making
such dispositions as she is or would be em-
powered to do by the said last will in
which case her relations might be depre-
ved of the benefits & entitl'd them by
such dispositions now in order to provide
against the same and in consideration of
the afflictions & sufferings experienced by

my said beloved wife from her sister Hannah
McAllister allister wife of all others
McAllister Esqrs - I do hereby in the
event of her death without making any
such disposition Give devise and bequeath
unto the said Hannah McAllister for and
during the term of her natural life the
possession and use of all my lands planta-
tions houses slaves and other property &
Estate lying and being in the State of
Georgia and upon her decease I give
devise and bequeath the same and every
part thereof to her children Matthew
Hall McAllister and Harriet Hannah
McAllister and to their heirs and assigns
forever equally to be divided between
them & I Give & Bequeath to my
Executor named in the said will One
Quarter Cask of Madeira wine each
and appoint Henry M Dyer Esquire
in the said will named together with Robert
Thompson of New Providence Esquire to act
with them as Executor to my said will
& Give to the said Henry M Dyer and
Robert Thompson One quarter Cask of Ma-
deira wine each and to the said Robert
Thompson Five Guinea to purchase a mor-
ning ring - Having given the like sum
to my other Executor for that purpose
and direct they hold to be taken as
and for part of my said will
