existence

First I do make ordain Publish and declare this to be my last
Will and Testament

Second I commend my body to the earth, and recommend myself to
Almighty God who gave it me Hoping and trusting in
him for a happy resurrection.

Third It is my Will and desire that my Executors after pay-
ment of my funeral expences and just debts bring my
said affairs to a satisfactory close, and pay over the
following Legacies.

Fourth I give and bequeath unto Eliza Maria Hughes all that
moiety or half part of a Stock of cattle which vested in
me by the will of John Bonnell of Scriven County.
Also one half part of a tract of land in the twenty
fourth district Wilkinson County, I also give and
bequeath to the said Eliza Maria Hughes, one half part
of a negro girl called Harriet in which Mr. Winifred
Bonnell has a life estate

Fifth I give and bequeath unto William Wilkie, son of Wilkie
of Savannah, a negro Boy called John the son of Nigrah

Sixth I give and bequeath unto Anne Butler, daughter of Greene
R. Duke of Savannah, a negro woman called Winifred

Seventh I give and bequeath to Michl. W. Hughes of Savannah
Physician, a negro man called Prince.

Eighth I desire and direct that my Executor do sell to the best
advantage for Cash, the following negroes viz: Herriah
and her husband Meper, and transmit the same to my
Brother Edward Hughes, of the City of Philadelphia, addressed
by letter to Philip Smith of said City.

Ninth It is my Will and desire that my Executors do sell
to the best advantage the balance of my Estate not
before particularized, and appropriate the proceeds to the
discharge of my said debts.

Tenth I do constitute and appoint my friends Dr. Michael
W. Hughes and Greene R. Duke Esq. to be my true &
lawfull executors to see this my last Will and
Testament carried into effect
