

In last Will & Testament of Jacob Abbott of the City of Savannah
Savannah County of Georgia and State of Georgia I
Jacob Abbott considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and
being of sound mind and memory do hereby declare my last Will and
Testament in manner and form following that is to say, I do
Give and bequeath unto my beloved nephews John Peter
and Michael Peter lawful begotten Children of Gertrude Peter
and Henry Peter my lawful Sister all that half lot in the
City of Savannah Chatham County, situated by me and
being in Evansburg containing nearly five acres and fifty
two feet land on Margaret Street adjoining lot of Lewis Cope
Cockhorse Waring Thomsen and a designation by the next of kin. Also
I do Give and bequeath unto my aforesaid nephews the one half
share by named Warrick to be made by Warrick
to be sold and disposed of after my death and the one half
of the proceeds to be paid over to my said nephews by my
executors hereinafter named. I also give and bequeath to my
two nieces also lawful begotten children of Gertrude Peter and
Henry Peter my Sister Say Peggy Peter & Clara Peter all
that space of Ground or half lot in the City of Savannah
County and State aforesaid being the north moiety or half
lot Chamberoff from Third to Fifth Avenue and from
to the north in a line sixty feet and from thence running
to the said land forty five feet and a boundary to the south
to the other moiety of said lot

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117 and bounded to the eastward by the north part of Lot number 16 and
 bounded to the westward by the north part of Lot number eight
 together with all and singular the buildings and improve-
 ments thereon and Shesly gave and bequeathed to my afore-
 said John Peter and Richard Peter and their heirs and
 assigns forever all that afore-said half lot Number 15 together
 with all and singular the buildings and improve-
 ments thereon belonging or as any thing
 also as before stated in this my last will and testament
 I gave and bequeathed unto my two nearest afore-said sons
 Paddy Peter & Charles Peter the afore-said last mentioned
 moiety or half lot Number 15 herein before described to-
 gether with all the improvements and hereditaments to them
 and their assigns forever and lastly I will give and bequeath
 to my two nearest afore-said sons Paddy Peter & Charles
 Peter the one half of a Negro boy herein before mentioned
 set forth and expressed to be sold and disposed of to the best
 advantage by my said Executors and the one half of the net
 proceeds to be paid over to my said sons or to their heirs
 and assigns. And lastly Shesly Wills and desire that should
 either of the afore-said legates die before they become of law-
 ful age that his or their proportion to be equally divided among
 the surviving legates and Shesly appoint constituted and
 make Robert Peter of the County of Offingham and I
 to James of the City of Savannah and County of Chatham
 my lawful Executors to this my last will and testament hereby
 making all former wills by me made. In witness whereof I
 have hereunto set my hand and Seal the first day of
 April in the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight hun-
 dred and nineteen Signed Sealed published and declar-
 ed by the above named Jacob Abart to be his last Will
 and testament in the presence of us who have hereunto sub-
 scribed our names as witnesses in the presence of the testator
 Robert Peter, C. D. Sparran, Jacob Abart, W. C. Barton, M.
 Richard W. Brock, J. S. Jones etc this 1st of April 1819
