Chatham County. In the name of God amen! I Robert Christie of the State & County aforesaid, widow being of sound mind & memory, but labouring under the infirmities of age & being desirous to arrange what few worldly affairs I have been pleased to bless me with, do make ordinance publish declare this to be my last will & Testament; & therefore I commit my body to its parent earth & recommend my soul to Almighty God who gave it me.— Item second I recommend my body to be interred in a plain & decent manner in the West quarter of the cemetery in Savannah.

Item third. I give & bequeath unto my three grand children namely Ann Christiana Christie, William Irvine Christie & Robert Jonathan Christie, children of Robert Christie and Hannah Christie his wife, and such other children as may be the lawful children of Robert Christie & Hannah Christie, my two negroes, namely Fendor & her son together with the future issue and increase of the said negro woman Fendor, to them and their heirs after the death of the said Robert & Hannah Christie—but in no wise whatever shall Chatham County 1817-1827 manage but for the support, maintenance & support of the children aforesaid.

Item fourth. I give and bequeath unto my grand children aforesaid, all the household, Kitchen furniture & stock of Cattle which I may die possessed of to them for their use, after the death of Robert & Hannah Christie to be used and engaged by these during their lives but for no other purpose.

Item fifth. It is my will and desire that my son Robert Christie be my sole Executor to carry this my last will & Testament into effect & execution.

In Testimony whereof I do publish and declare this instrument of writing to contain my will & desires and to be my last will & Testament.

American Independence.
