

In the name of God, I, John Barnard of the County of Stafford, State of Virginia, being of sound mind, memory & understanding, do make this my last Will and Testament, as follows.

I will and direct that all my just debts and several expenses shall be fully paid as soon as conveniently can be after my decease.

I desire that my Estate be kept together and managed to the best advantage for the benefit of my legatees until the first Day of January next after the expiration of Twelve months after my decease.

I give devise and bequeath to my son Timothy Barnard One Hundred Acres of Land to be taken from the East Side of the Five Hundred Acre Tract on which I live, by a Strait Line, to commence at the Marshall's parallel with the

Ten Hundred Acre Tract, or Ten Hundred and Fifty Acre Tract which my son Timothy now owned until it shall be back Line of the said Five Hundred Acre Tract, which said One Hundred Acres of Land I give to my son Timothy during his natural life, and after his death to his son John Barnard & Timothy Barnard & their heirs forever to be divided between them as my said son Timothy may think proper and direct by Will or other words.

I give devise and bequeath to my son John Barnard the remainder of the Five Hundred Acre Tract of Land, on which I live (Subject to a provision hereinafter expressed) of which said Tract of Land I give and bequeath to my said son John W. Barnard during his natural life, and after his death then to his lawful issue forever, but should my said son John W. Barnard depart this life without lawful

issue, then I give devise the same to his Brothers and their lawful issue forever. I give devise and bequeath to my Daughter Mary E. Barnard for her residence, if she think proper to live there, the use of my House on Washington Island in which I now live together with the garden Orchard, the out Buildings and three acres of Land immediately adjacent to the settlement as long as she may remain unmarried, but in the event of her Marriage or death then the same to be to and for my son John W. Barnard as included in the foregoing devise to him and upon the limitations therein expressed.
