and memory and understanding do make this my last will
and testament in manner and form following I give devise
and bequeath unto my friend Paul Peter Thompson of Savannah
all my money goods effects and Chattels real and personal
for him his heirs for ever on the following Conditions that Char-
lotte Ann shall have the enjoyment of half my said property dur-
ing her natural life I recommend to him Phillip Lee and
request him to cause the said Phillip Lee to learn a trade to
his liking. I do now name and appoint the said Paul P Thom-
pson executor of this my last will and testament hereby rev-
oking and making void and every other Will or Wills made
at any time heretofore by me made, and do declare this to be
my last will and testament. In testimony

set my hand and seal on my plantation the twenty fifth day of
March one thousand eight hundred and eight
signed sealed and published by the above
named Joseph Boguille as and for his last
will and testament in the presence of us
who at his request and in his presence
have subscribed our names as witnesses thereto

Personally appeared Lewis H. Fark. who being duly sworn saith
he was well acquainted with Joseph Boguille deceased and with
his manner of hand writing having frequently seen him write and
subscribe his name that he was the attending physician of the said
deceased and saw him the day before he died when he was per-
fectly sensible and collected, that his disorder was Catarrhus ves-
icæ not such as to affect his mind, that he heard him frequently speak
of his attachment to Paul P. Thompson and of his intention to
leave him what he possessed. That he verily believes the signature
Joseph Boguille subscribed to the within instrument of writing pur-
porting to be his last will and testament is the proper hand
writing and signature of the said Joseph Boguille deceased
before in Open Court
