and To my son John Bransley I give one fourth
of my Estate both real and personal.

and I do hereby direct that as my said three
children are minors that the division of
my estate both real and personal shall not
take place until they my children arrive
separately at the lawful age when each
shall have their share that is to say their
fourth part and finally I leave my said
life insurance to my said children during
and Guardian to my said children during
their minority, directing that as each of my
children arrive at the lawful age to have a
share that is to say one third and each of
them their fourth part, the said estate of
decease and residue should be applied for the
use it is divided. Dated this 16th day of January
