I give devise and bequeath unto my dear Wife Sarah and to my Children Elizabeth Jane and Agnes All my Estate both real and personal of whatsoever kind and nature to be equally divided between them to hold the same to them their heirs and assigns forever But my Estate is not to be divided but kept together untill my youngest child arrives at age

In case of the death of all my said Wife and Children I give devise and bequeath all my Estate to the Children of my Sister the Wife of Mr John Oppinger to be shared between them and held forever

I authorize my Executors herein after named to hire out my Neg^r Slaves or to work them as may be best reserving for house use such as shall be necessary and I authorize her to sell such as as may be misbehave or such as are necessary to be sold

My Cattle are to be sold to pay my debts if such sale be necessary or they are to be kept for the use of my wife & children I direct all useful furniture and personal Estate and such horses as are not necessary to be kept to be sold for the benefit of my Estate And I do appoint and constitute my Wife Sarah Executrix of this my last Will and Testament

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal at Savannah this twenty first day of October One thousand eight hundred and twenty
