do make and ordain this my last will and
testaments in manner and form following to wit: That
of all I recommend my soul to my heavenly Father whom
it And my body to be decently interred at the discretion of my
Executors hereafter named And as to what worldly goods
it hath pleased Almighty God to bless me with, I give
dispose of in the following manner (that is to say) I give
devise and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Elizabeth
Mingledorff wife on John Mingledorff one full and
equal half part of all that land or parcel of land which

at Yamacraw in the City of Savannah containing sixty acres
part part and one hundred and twenty feet in depth between by
the water &c and subjects to a claim a lot formerly belonging to
the late John De la Rigue &c also give and bequeath unto my
daughter Elizabeth one fourth part of the lot or parcel of land
whereon now live containing thirty feet in front on Market Street
(formerly John Cramm's) and forty five feet by the lot now owned
by McCallister together with the dwelling House Buildings and Im-
provements and other appurtenances on the same standing and
being or thereunto in any wise belonging or appertaining. I do
also give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth my
negro man Hans &c and all my House hold and kitchen
furniture To have and to hold the said lots or parcels of land
negro man Hans &c and furniture unto my said daughter
Elizabeth to the only proper sole and separate use and beho-
of her my said daughter and her assigns for and during the
term of her natural life, and not to be subject or liable to the
debts or control of her present or any future husband and
from and after her decease the same to go and be equally
divided between the children of my said daughter Elizabeth three
and share alike to them and their heirs and assigns forever.

I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Rachel
Sturges (wife of Samuel Sturges of Weymouth) three fourths
parts of the lot or parcel of land whereon now live contain-
ing thirty feet in front on Market Street formerly John Cramm's
and sixty feet on the lane back of
said lot together with the dwelling House Buildings
Improvements and other appurtenances on the same
standing and being or thereunto in any wise belonging
or appertaining. I also give devise and bequeath unto my
said daughter Rachel all that tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County of Chatham containing
by Original Survey Fifty acres bounded at the time of the
Original Survey by Nicholas Kemner and others and
originally granted to Sinclair Waters as by reference to
the Original Plat and Grant will more fully appear. To have
and to hold the said lots or parcels of land unto my
said daughter Rachel Sturges to the only proper sole and
separate use and beho- of her the said Rachel my daughter
and her assigns for and during her natural life and
not to be subject or liable to the debts or control of her pres-
ent or any future husband and from and after her decease
the same to go and be equally divided between the children
of the said Rachel Sturges three and share alike to them
their heirs and assigns forever.
