the following negroes, all of whom have been born on my Estate, to

George the third of Savannah, Clara with my special desire that
she treat with kindness Jacob, Clara, and Amy, all my property
so devised and bequeathed unto the said Doctor Mel-

Estate, until all my just and lawful debts are paid, whereupon
the said tract or parcel of land devised and bequeathed
as aforesaid, includes the establishment of five or six
houses, an office Overseers House and the buildings near there-
